North Landing Bridge to close for piling repairs

NORFOLK, Va. -- The North Landing Bridge in Chesapeake, Va., will undergo the final stage of repairs to its pilings from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., March 12-16, 2003. During repairs, the bridge will close to vehicular traffic for up to six hours, weather permitting.

Motorists traveling north on Mount Pleasant Road in Chesapeake can detour around the bridge by using Centerville Turnpike to Elbow Road to Indian River Road, back to North Landing Road, or by using Fentress Airfield Road to Blackwater Road to Pungo Ferry Road to Princess Anne Road to Indian River Road, back to North Landing Road. The detour should be followed in reverse for motorists traveling south on North Landing Road in Virginia Beach.

The Corps and the Coast Guard have issued a notice to mariners; however, they anticipate little or no effect during final repairs. Bridge operators monitor marine channel 13.
