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Deep Creek Bridge to undergo repairs

CHESAPEAKE, VA. -- The Deep Creek Bridge will undergo minor emergency repairs to the plate where the bridge abuts the road on Thursday, February 5, from 2:00 a.m. to approximately 6:00 a.m.

The bridge will need to be in the up position to do the repairs. However, it will be lowered to allow vehicles to cross as needed. The gates will be down and traffic lights on, and a flagger will be onsite to direct traffic.

While the Corps is trying to minimize impact, motorists can expect delays during this time. The following alternate routes are suggested:

Vehicles traveling south on George Washington Highway in Deep Creek should take I-64 West to Dominion Boulevard and then travel south on Cedar Road back to George Washington Highway.

Vehicles traveling south on Cedar Road or north on George Washington Highway and needing to cross the Deep Creek Bridge should take Dominion Boulevard to I-64 East to George Washington Highway.
