Page 8, paragraph 3.3.2.a, line 2, change "contaminatedperformed" to "contaminated and shall be performed".

Page 4, paragraph 3.2, line 16, change "Size No. 57" to "Size No. 3 or 3a".

a. Page 2, paragraph 1.2, delete paragraph content and substitute therefore "PARAGRAPH DELETED".

b. Page 2, paragraph 1.3, delete paragraph content and substitute therefore the following: "Payment for all work in connection with this SECTION shall be included in the lump sum payment item for Placement Area construction."

c. Page 7, paragraph 3.3.1, delete the second sentence and substitute therefore the following: "Geotextile for reinforcement shall not be overlapped, but sewn as specified below, except in the northeast corner from station 27+00 to 29+50 where it shall be overlapped as follows. In the reach from station 27+00 to 29+50 the geotextile shall be laid out in a fan pattern with the machine direction as specified above. Also in this reach, from station 27+00 to 29+50, overlaps will be required to get full coverage while still having a continuous geotextile in the machine direction, the geotextile width shall be a minimum 40 feet in the cross direction, as well as full length in the machine direction."

7. SECTION 02881:

Page 1, paragraph 1.2, line 9, after "...disposal area." insert "The Contractor should anticipate encountering trees and other similar organic debris within the dredging area. The Contractor will be allowed to utilize mechanical equipment to relocate this material in order to maximize his dredging processes. At his option, this debris can be moved from the dredging area and relocated within the waterway in proximity of the dredging area or removed and disposed off site as specified for organic debris unsuitable for the placement area. The Contractor is informed that no matter which option the Contractor may choose to employ in conducting the dredging work in this manner, all such effort will be at the Contractor's expense and additional payment will not be due the Contractor. Where bedrock is identified within the dredging prism, the Contractor is not expected to dredge bedrock material; however, it is anticipated the Contractor will re move all designated dredge material within the dredging prism to the maximum extent practical."
