


SEASHORE-MALLOW
Kosteletzkya virginica

Located in salt and brackish marshes and shores from Long Island, South.

A perennial relative of *Hibiscus*; 0.5 to 1.5 m high; branching and somewhat hairy. Leaves are green or grey-green; lower ones oval; upper ones with 3-5 lobes; edges with unequally spaced teeth. Flowers pink with yellow center; five petals; 2.5 to 5 cm diameter; blooming in late July through September.
