



CLIMBING HEMPWEED

Mikania scandens

Located in swamps, moist soils and along the banks of streams throughout the Division. Also known as Boneset.

A nearly hairless twining vine growing to 5 meters length, the opposite leaves are triangular, heart shaped or with lobes near the base; gradually pointed at the tip; on stalks; leaf margins wavy or bluntly toothed; 5 to 10 cm long; 2 to 5 cm wide. Flowers located in much-branched clusters at the ends of stalks arising from the junction of the stem and leafstalks; white or pink; blooming from July through September.
