

## DENSE-FLOWERED ST. JOHN'S-WORT

*Hypericum densiflorum*

Located in swamps and wet, acid soils on Long Island, in New Jersey and south. Also known as Bushy St. John's-Wort.

A freely branching, woody shrub; branches, slender, somewhat angled and branchlets 2-edged; 0.5 to 2 m high. Leaves crowded, opposite, long and narrow (2 to 5 cm long, 2 to 6 mm wide), pointed, with smaller leaves clustered in the axils of the larger. Flowers are numerous in densely crowded clusters mostly at the ends of branchlets; 5-petaled, yellow, 1.2 to 1.7 cm in diameter; blooming from July to September.
