

SEA-ROCKET
Cakile edentula

Located on sandy and gravelly beaches and shores throughout the Division.

A succulent bushy branched annual; 5 to 85 cm high. Leaves fleshy, oblong, toothed and narrow at the base; to 10 cm long. Flowers, small, light purple, blooming from July through September. Seed pods two-jointed; egg-shaped above, narrower below; very distinctive.





SALT-MARSH FLEABANE
Pluchea purpurascens

Located in salt and brackish marshes throughout the Division. Also known as Camphor-Weed.

A branched, erect, hairy annual; to 1.5 m high. Leaves bluish-green, oval or lance-shaped; tooth-edged; attached directly to stem. Flowers pink to purple; grouped in upright clusters on the ends of branches; blooming from July through September.
