



SALTMARSH BULRUSH  
*Scirpus robustus*

Located in brackish and saline coastal marshes throughout the Division.

A perennial sedge with a stiff, 3 angled stem (sides flat); 0.7 to 1.5 m high. Leaves dark green with prominent mid rib; smooth; taller than main stem; 2 to 4 unequally long leaves found below the cluster of spikelets, similar to those on the main stem. Spikelets, 6-20, brown or reddish-brown and hairy; forming end clusters.
