MEMORANDUM FOR: U.S. COAST GUARD CAPTAIN OF THE PORT.

SUBJECT: Temporary Expansion of Restricted Area at the Naval Operating Base (NOB) Norfolk, Virginia. (33 CFR 334.30).

The District Engineer, at the request of The United States Coast Guard has authorized a temporary extension of the established Restricted Area at NOB for a special event to be held on 31 July 2009.

Pursuant to the authority granted in 33 C.F.R. 209.200, 334.3(c), 33 U.S.C. 1 and 33 U.S.C. 3, The District Engineer has authorized the United States Coast Guard, Sector Hampton Roads, the authority to extend and control the Restricted Area listed in 33 CFR 334.30 as necessary to provide adequate protection during the event.

The United States Coast Guard will establish a Broadcast Notice to Mariner to inform the maritime community of specific requirements as soon as practical. The on scene coordinator/commander will monitor VHF channel 16 and 13 at all times during the event.

Sector Hampton Road and/or the designated on scene Coordinator and/or Commander are authorized to expand the over all size of the existing Restricted Area and control over all persons and maritime traffic including, but not limited to, commercial and recreational traffic for the duration of this event.

The regulation in this section, established by the United States Army Corps of Engineers, Norfolk District may be enforced by any Federal, State or Local agency as Directed by the United States Coast Guard, Sector Hampton Roads.
