MEMORANDUM FOR: U.S. COAST GUARD CAPTAIN OF THE PORT, THE COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA EMERGENCY OPERATIONS CENTER AND DOMINION POWER.

SUBJECT: Designation of restricted area at the Surry Power Plant adjacent to the James River, a navigable waters of the United States within the Commonwealth of Virginia.

The District Engineer, at the request of Dominion Power and in conjunction with proposals from the Nuclear Regulatory Commission, established a Local Order on March 14, 2002 that authorized a restricted area in the vicinity of the cooling intake structure at the Surry Power Plant.

A Public Notice dated January 14, 2003 was published announcing our intent to re-authorize the restricted area for a period of one year. No comments opposing this proposal were received. The District Engineer has determined that the proposal is necessary in safeguarding the facility, the surrounding community, the Public and the environment and is not contrary to public interest. Based on these findings, The United States Army Corps of Engineers, Norfolk District, pursuant to the authority granted in 33 C.F.R. 209.200, 334.3(c) and 33 U.S.C. 1, has established a restricted in waters of the United States as follows:

James River, Surry Nuclear Power Plant, Surry Virginia, Restricted Area

(a) **The Area:** . (1) The waters within an area beginning at Mean High Water on the shore at latitude 37°08'59.4"N, longitude 76°40'15.5" W; thence to the following points creating a 500 yard arc; latitude 37°08'58.8" N, longitude 76°40'06" W; latitude 37°09'03.1" N, longitude 76°39'59.4" W; latitude 37°09'06.9" N, longitude 76°39'54.1" W; latitude 37°09'12.8" N, longitude 76°39'48" W; latitude 37°09'18.6" N, longitude 76°39'48" W; latitude 37°09'25.1" N, longitude 76°39'48.3" W; latitude 37°09'32.3" N, longitude 76°39'50.1" W; latitude 37°09'37.2" N, longitude 76°39'53.1" W; latitude 37°09'40" N, longitude 76°39'56.6" W; latitude 37°09'37.2" N, longitude 76°39'53.1" W; latitude 37°09'43.4" N, longitude 76°40'03.4" W; thence to a point on shore at Mean High Water in position; latitude 37°09'42.7" N, longitude 76°40'27.1" W **(amended 11-17-2010) and the entire discharge canal from jetty at the mouth of the discharge canal to the circulating water discharge pipes at the head of the discharge canal. The geographic coordinates for this are 37°10'18.3" N, 76°42'22.5" W and include the entire width of the canal.**

(b) The Regulations. (1) No vessel or persons may enter the restricted area established in accordance with this regulation without the permission of the persons in charge, or persons or agencies authorized to act in his/her behalf. For authorization to enter the restricted area mariners are directed to contact the Surry Security Supervisor, Patrol Commander (VHF Channel 13 or 16) or the Norfolk District Corps of Engineers Regulatory Branch.

(2) The Commonwealth of Virginia Emergency Operations Center, United States Coast Guard Captain of the Port or the District Engineer may, at any time, increase the overall size of this restricted area as deemed necessary for the safety and security of the Port, Public, Environment or Economy. Any increase in the size of the area will be related to a specific threat and shall remain only so long as the threat exists.

(3) Waterfront property owners, commercial or private located within the restricted area shall have unrestricted access to their property unless there is a specific threat/ heightened security situation.

(c) Enforcement. (1) The regulation in this section, promulgated by the United States Army Corps of Engineers may be enforced by any Federal Agency, State, Local or County Law Enforcement agency, or Private Security Firms in the employment of the facility, so long as the entity undertaking to enforce this Restricted Area has the legal authority to do so under the appropriate Federal, State, or Local laws.

(d) Effective Date: This order is effective immediately.

(e) Duration: This order shall remain in effect until further notice.
