**PROGRAMMATIC AGREEMENT AMONG
U.S. ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS
NORFOLK DISTRICT REGULATORY OFFICE,
ADVISORY COUNCIL ON HISTORIC PRESERVATION,
VIRGINIA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY AND
VIRGINIA STATE HISTORIC PRESERVATION OFFICE
REGARDING IMPLEMENTATION OF THE NORFOLK DISTRICT CORPS OF
ENGINEERS STATE PROGRAM GENERAL PERMIT AND SECTION 106 OF THE
NATIONAL HISTORIC PRESERVATION ACT**

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Norfolk District announces an amended Programmatic Agreement between the Norfolk District Corps of Engineers, the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation, the Virginia Department of Environmental Quality and the Virginia State Historic Preservation Office executed under Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act.

The Norfolk District Corps of Engineers' State Program General Permit, 12-SPGP-01, provides Corps regulatory authorization in Virginia for residential, commercial, and institutional developments impacting up to one (1) acre of nontidal wetlands and waters and up to 2,000 linear feet of streambed, and also for linear transportation projects impacting up to 1/3 acre of nontidal waters and wetlands. The Programmatic Agreement (PA) authorizes the Virginia Department of Environmental Quality (VDEQ) to conduct the initial review of existing information on historic properties for permit applications submitted under the 12-SPGP-01.

The State Program General Permit Section 106 Programmatic Agreement (SPGP PA) was originally executed in October, 2008. In 2011, the SPGP-01 and the SPGP PA were proposed to be amended, and details regarding the amendments and requests for comments were provided in a public notice dated June 22, 2011. The SPGP PA has been amended as proposed and updated with current information and references.
