Defense Supply Center Richmond Restoration Advisory Board
Meeting Minutes
April 12, 2004

The meeting for the Defense Supply Center Richmond (DSCR) Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) was held at Bensley Community Building on April 12, 2004. The meeting began at 7:30 PM. A quorum was present.

Issues Log – Mr. Parrish reviewed items added to the log at the previous RAB meeting.

Technical Training Session –“*Designing for Response Performance and Completion: The Role of Applicable or Relevant and Appropriate Requirements (ARARs) and Remedial Action Objectives (RAOs)*”, a technical briefing handout, was provided to RAB members, followed by a presentation from Mr. Steve Edlavitch, DSCR, and Leigh Benson, Mitretek.

Public Forum – Ms. Pat McCoy, resident of Rayon Park, expressed her concern for the health and welfare of the citizens of her community, who are still very concerned about air and groundwater quality. Although the residents know that DSCR is still conducting tests, they don't know the results and are concerned that they won't receive warnings or health advisories. Mr. Steve Edlavitch responded that DSCR has an obligation to inform residents if they are in danger.

Administrative Items

- Minutes – Ms. Young motioned to approve the RAB minutes from February 2004 as edited. Mr. McCoy seconded. Voting: (8) members voted for the motion, (0) against and (0) abstained.
- Minutes – Ms. Clarke motioned to approve the RAB minutes from March 2004. Mr. McCoy seconded. Voting: (8) members voted for the motion, (0) against and (0) abstained.
- The RAB requested the DSCR Public Affairs Officer (PAO) to send copies of meeting materials to those RAB members not present. This will be the procedure for all future meetings that members cannot attend.
