Defense Supply Center Richmond Restoration Advisory Board
Meeting Minutes
April 11, 2005

The meeting for the Defense Supply Center Richmond (DSCR) Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) was held at Bensley Community Building on April 11, 2005. The meeting began at 7:30 p.m. A quorum was present.

Issues Log

- Ms. Moe requested that her issue regarding hazardous waste that she submitted during the public meeting be added to the Issues Log.
- RAB members requested additional information for plans to update the Web site for the cleanup program.
- Ms. Moe requested examples of other chlorinated volatile organic compound (CVOC) sites and remediation efforts used on those sites.
- Ms. Moe requested additional information on common uses of perchlorethane (PCA).

Public Forum

- Mr. Beadles discussed the outdated information currently on the cleanup program Web site. Mr. Zoeckler responded that DSCR is currently making plans to revamp the site. This issue was added to the Issues Log for additional discussion at future RAB meetings.
- Mr. McCoy made the comment that DSCR officials should try to avoid using acronyms, especially at public meetings such as the one held recently for the OU12 Proposed Plan.
- Ms. Jackson, Better Housing Coalition, discussed appointing an alternate (Josh Galloway) for the Better Housing Coalition.

Technical Briefing

- Mr. Edlavitch presented a status update on the DSCR cleanup program.
- “Natural Attenuation of Chlorinated Solvents,” a status briefing handout, was provided to RAB members, followed by a presentation from Mr. Zoeckler.

Public Comment

- There were no comments from the public.

Administrative Items

- Membership – Mr. Beadles moved to allow the Better Housing Coalition appoint an alternate for Ms. Jackson on the RAB. Mr. Brooks seconded the motion. Voting: 6 members voted for the motion, 0 against, and 0 abstained.

- Minutes – Ms. Moe requested that March meeting minutes be edited to reflect that a quorum consists of 5 RAB members only as long as there are only 9 RAB members in total. Mr. McCoy made a motion to approve the RAB minutes from March 2005 as amended. Mr. Beadles seconded. Voting: 6 members voted for the motion, 0 against, and 0 abstained.
- Ms. Salvati, Chester County Office of Water Quality, will make a presentation in May on the creek sampling program.
- Mr. Grimes will replace Eric Salopek as the Virginia DEQ representative at this and future RAB meetings.

Meeting Adjourned – Mr. Beadles moved to adjourn the meeting. Mr. McCoy seconded. The meeting was adjourned at 9:26 p.m.
