Source Area 6-Track K Dump Proposed Plan

The U.S. Army Corps removed approximately 58 tons of tires, paint cans, household appliances and wastes from the site in 2001 in order to investigate the site soils. The Corps also conducted soil sampling 3 times at the site between 2001 and 2004 and completed human health and ecological risk assessments. Results of these studies indicate that contaminants are not present in the soil in concentrations that would pose a risk to human health or the local ecosystem. Based on these findings, the U.S. Army Corps is proposing no further action for the Source Area 6 -Track K Dump. The 12-page Proposed Plan document is available for public review on the Army Corps project website and in the Administrative Record which is located at the Tidewater Community College Portsmouth Campus Library, 7000 College Drive and in the U.S. Army Corps Norfolk District office.
