



MOCK BISHOP-WEED
Ptilimnium capillaceum

Located in brackish to fresh marshes throughout the Division, primarily along the coast. Also known as Herb-William, Wood-Nep, Bole-on-Bull-Wort.

A slender-stemmed, loosely branched annual; 0.1 to 1.9 m high. The alternate leaves are deeply divided into untoothed, threadlike segments. The small, 5-petaled, white flowers are clustered on long umbrella-like rays (2 to 16 rays per cluster each 2.5 to 5 cm long); clusters are 5 to 10 cm wide; flowers blooming from July to October.
