


MARSH-ELDER

Iva imbricata

Located in coastal sands and the transition zone from Virginia and south.

A small woody relative of *Iva frutescens*; 0.3 to 1.0 m high. Leaves alternate on stem; fleshy; without teeth or with 1-5 teeth on each edge; oblong or lance-shaped; attached directly to the stem. Flowers greenish-white, blooming from August through October. Fruits are green pods located along the branches; 0.6 to 1.3 cm diameter.
