

GIBBONS PANICGRASS

Sacciolepis striata

Located in shallow water, ditches and swamps from southern New Jersey and south.

A perennial grass from a creeping base. Stems erect, fragile, branching; 0.3 to 2 m high. Leaves forming sheathes around stem: lower sheathes densely hairy, upper naked. Leaf blades flat, hairless; 4 to 20 cm long, 1 cm wide. Flowering spike densely covered with spikelets on all sides; 5 to 30 cm long; blooming from August to October.
