



FALSE PIMPERNEL  
*Lindernia dubia*

Located along lakes, streams, and fresh tidal shores, wet open areas and disturbed wet soil throughout the Division. Highly variable with several recognized varieties. Similar to *L. anagallidea* which is also found throughout the Division.

An unbranched to much branching annual, with a slender, usually erect stem; 5 to 35 cm long. Leaves are oblong or oval, toothless (may be slightly clasping the stem; lower 1 to 3 cm long; upper usually smaller. Single purplish or white, 2-lipped flowers at the ends of long stalks which arise from the upper leaf axils; blooming from late June to October.
