



Description:

Approximately 11,000 Gallons Fuel Oil Released In 1978

- Fuel Migrated Through Storm Sewer Line To Low Area Near Creek**
- Area Filled In With 4 To 10 Feet Fill**

Chemicals Detected In Soil:

Heavy Fuel Oil And Metals




