- **Location/size of site:** 700-foot section along the south bank of the James River.
- **What was found?** A disposal area containing scrap metal, concrete slabs, slag material, bricks, and other construction debris.
- **Work completed?** Removal efforts were completed in September 2001. The Corps installed a revetment (stone facing) to protect the shoreline from erosion.
- **What's next?** A remedial investigation/feasibility study and risk assessment to determine what future requirements remain.
