
EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This Integrated Cultural Resources Management Plan (ICRMP) is the third iteration, and a revision of the current Dugway Proving Ground (DPG) Cultural Resource Management Plan. This ICRMP outlines the DPG Cultural Resources Management Program from a cultural landscape approach and defines how DPG will meet its legal compliance requirements and support the military mission in accordance with Army Regulation 200-1.

The ICRMP discusses DPG's military mission, which contributes to its military landscape. All laws and regulations governing cultural resource management are summarized, and their implications on DPG are addressed. An inventory of the natural landscape includes both natural elements and environmental change as it relates to human history. An overview of the cultural landscape describes known historic properties and cultural resources located on the DPG military installation and the associated prehistoric, historic, and military contexts. The management plan states the objectives, methods, priorities, and policies that the Cultural Resource Management Officer (CRMO) will follow for the identification, consultation, evaluation, treatment, reporting, and management of all cultural resources.

A series of standard operating procedures (SOP's) supplements the management plan. These documents address the National Historic Preservation Act, NRHP evaluation standards, the Archaeological Resource Protection Act, Native American Graves Protection and Repatriation Act, Inventory Procedures, NRHP eligibility testing, analysis and curation of cultural materials, inadvertent discovery of archeological materials, the maintenance of Historic Buildings and Structures, and tribal consultation and coordination.
