MEMORANDUM FOR FORT HUNTER LIGGETT FAMILY HOUSING PERSONNEL

SUBJECT: Notification of Water Sampling from selected AFH units.

1. The purpose of this memorandum is to request your participation in the U.S. Army's ongoing effort to ensure Soldiers, Civilians, and Family Members have access to safe drinking water.
2. The Installation Management Command (IMCOM) is conducting water sampling at various Army facilities where children six years old and under may consume a significant amount of drinking water for the presence of lead in drinking water. These facilities include child development centers, youth centers, elementary schools and residential areas. This sampling effort is a continuation of the effort begun in 2013 to ensure that the Army is being as protective as possible of the children in its care.
3. This effort is separate from the annual lead and copper testing that is conducted in accordance with State Water Board requirements. This effort is centrally managed to ensure sampling and analysis protocols are the same across all Army facilities.
4. Previous sampling results indicated no lead levels above Federal and State Action levels.
5. Drinking water sample containers along with testing procedures will be delivered to the locations on the attached sheet on the specified date, 8 November 2016. Sample containers along with procedures will be left at the front door of these addresses. We request that you conduct the sampling on the following day, 9 November 2016 and leave the samples outside the front door upon completion. Personnel will start collecting the samples at approximately 0900 hours.
