

RECORD OF ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS (REC)

PROJECT TITLE: Repair Foundation Cracks and Waterproof South Bsmt Wall-Qtrs 7 Project# 2015-4823

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT: Provide labor, material, and equipment to repair foundation cracks and waterproof south basement wall of Quarters 7. The Lead Mitigation contractor's scope of work shall include, but is not limited to: Provide 10-day notification to IEPA prior to start of work and to obtain permit. Following initial basement floor testing by the Environmental Contractor, safely strip the basement wall to bare concrete, apply 2 coats of white paint to 85 SF area where LBP was removed. Upon completion of mitigation procedures, contact POC for independent testing lab hired by RIIS for follow-up floor testing.

A copy of the lead-based paint form shall also be submitted to George Schaub, IMRI-PWE, 2-6379, prior to start of any work.

Prior to start of any work, this project shall be coordinated with Industrial Hygiene, 2-0806.

This project involves work on the interior of an existing building; therefore, coordination with the Illinois State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO) is not required due to pending Programmatic Agreement.

Anticipated date and/or duration of proposed action: (MM/DD/YY): 60 days

Reason for using a record of environmental consideration:

a. Per 32 CFR Part 651.29(a) (1, 2, and 3): The action has not been segmented, no exceptional circumstances exist (b) (1-14), and one or more of the Categorical Exclusions (CX's) encompass the proposed action.

b.
