**Project Title:** Repair Windows, Quarters 7

**Project #** 92552/2017-6753

**Anticipated date and/or duration of proposed action:** 120 days

**Brief Description of the Project:** Provide labor, materials & equipment to install energy efficient replacement windows at Quarters 7. ACM and LBP are not expected to have an impact on this project, due to the multiple coats of latex paint encapsulation of the LBP on the window units. The window units and trim will be considered and disposed of as construction debris. Exterior soil testing will be conducted prior and post construction.

**This Project is Categorically Excluded Under:**
