There are no recurring tests required in family housing. All units were tested below 2 pCi/L. Retests are only required if a building has a mitigation system installed or has recently undergone a major renovation.

505 and 506 Sherman Ct do have mitigation systems installed, but have been tested in Oct 13. They will not be due until Oct 2018 for retesting.
