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# EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Vision Plan is a critical step towards creating a comprehensive and flexible master plan. The intent of the Vision Plan is to provide a flexible guideline for future infrastructure development as commanders, stakeholders and missions change through the years. There is a unique relationship between the mission requirements of an Army Materiel Command (AMC) installation and the traditional garrison and community support that an Army post provides; therefore the Vision Plan strives to provide the foundation and vision needed for the development of holistic, compliant, realistic, and executable planning actions now and in the future.

Stakeholder involvement is essential in the Vision Plan process because it engages and incorporates the thoughts and ideas of those directly involved in carrying out the mission. This greatly contributes to the applicability and longevity of the plan. Common themes and design challenges were established early in the planning process through stakeholder interviews on 3-6

February 2015. Approximately 30 stakeholders participated in the Tobyhanna Army Depot (TYAD) Vision Plan Workshop held 4-5 February 2015. During the Workshop, with the leadership of a planning team, Soldiers and civilian stakeholders who live and work at TYAD refined an existing vision, defined goals and created complementary design language that addresses key planning issues. The resulting planning vision, design principles, and Framework Plan serve as a guide for future master planning efforts related to infrastructure.

## KEY ASSUMPTIONS

- Focus on consolidation and modernization.
- Follow existing AT/FP policies.
- New development will occur within the installation cantonment boundary and outside of areas with natural, cultural, or mission constraints.
- Comply with the regulating plan and building envelope standards.
- When planning projects for new structures are programmed, prioritize functional adjacencies and synergy.
