- **B.** Typical year assessment(s): The Corps Antecedent Precipitation Tool indicates that while higher than average rainfall was experienced in the weeks prior to the consultant collecting data on the site, that the site was at the maximum of the normal range at the time the site was visited. This would indicate that with the primary and secondary indicators being absent during the site visit that the site lacks they hydrology parameter during a normal year.
