- **C.** Additional comments to support AJD: Based on aerial photos and the previous delineation confirmation, Ditches A, C, E, F and G were not constructed in a tributary, do not relocate a tributary and were not constructed in an adjacent wetland, and therefore would not meet the current definition of Waters of the U.S.

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
