- **D.** The ROW site is approximately 5.5 acres, the ROW is along Edwin Drive and a short piece of Edinburgh Lane south of Hillcrest Parkway and north of Red Knot Way, it consisted of open roadside

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area. The open grass fields had no indicators of hydrology and contained Digitaria sanguinalis & Cynodon dactylon which are FACU indicative of non-wetland grassed fields. During the site investigations, no potential wetland areas were identified. Swales in the 5.5acre Edwin Drive and Edinburgh Lane Right-of-Way had no ordinary high water marks, no surface water connection, no flow, and no connection to upstream wetlands or other waters of the U.S.

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
