U.S. Army Corps of Engineers – Norfolk District (Corps) Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) VDOT 22-SPGP PRELIMINARY SCREENING PROCESS

The preliminary screening process is proposed to help expedite Corps review of delineations for permitting and federal coordination for Section 7, Section 106, Section 408, and Tribal review. This process is proposed for use with 22-SPGP-LT projects that occur within the Commonwealth of Virginia **AND** that have state/federal funding.

- A. When a project does not have a Corps confirmed delineation/jurisdictional determination VDOT can submit copy of the project plan(s) for review and confirmation.
- B. When a project has a Corps confirmed delineation/jurisdictional determination the VDOT will submit:
 - 1. A location map that clearly identifies the project boundaries and includes the longitude and latitude.
 - 2. The project plan(s) that will be submitted with the permit application.

C. Federal review:

The Corps will review the preliminary screening request to determine the following:

- 1. If the delineation is acceptable for use with a permit application.
- 2. If Section 408 coordination is required.
- 3. If Tribal coordination is required.
- 4. If the development plan is acceptable for federal coordination (when applicable).

^{*}If the project plans change federal review and federal coordination will be completed through and in accordance with the 22-SPGP-LT permit process and VDOT 22-SPGP SOP.
