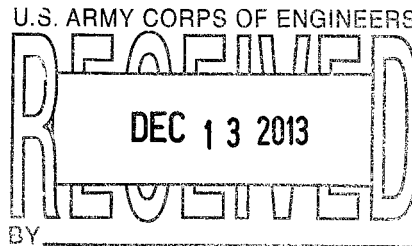

Dear Mr. Steffey

After reviewing NAO-2012-00080/13-V0408 Dominion Surry-Skiffes Ck-Wheaton Project, the Coast Guard has comments pursuant to 33 CFR 62, 64 and 66. The actions listed below, if taken by the applicant, do not absolve the owner of this application of any liability.

If this application is approved the Coast Guard has the following marking requirements:

1. Each of the fenders; total four, must be lighted with a visible all around slow flashing amber (yellow) light with a minimum candela setting twenty-four (24). Lighting equipment should be placed in the approximate center of each individual fender.
2. Towers 21, 22, 25 and 26 shall be lighted with a minimum of one visible all around slow flashing white light with a minimum candela setting of twenty-four (24). Lighting equipment should be placed on the tower side opposite of the fender light and at a minimum height of 15' above MHW.
3. Towers 20, 23, 24 and 27 shall be lighted with a minimum of two (2) visible all around slow flashing white light with a minimum candela setting of twenty-four (24). Lighting equipment should be placed on opposite sides of each tower in an approximate East/West alignment and at minimum height of 15' above MHW.
4. In association with these marking requirements the applicant must prepare and provide for Coast Guard approval a Private Aids to Navigation application (Form CG-2554). If the applicant would like to mark towers or fenders not listed above, or add additional lights to those listed above, those elected additions should be included on the CG-2554.

Also, the contractor must notify this office three weeks prior to the beginning of their project with pertinent information so it can be included in the Local Notice to Mariners (LNM). This request can be done either by email and/or letter.
