

## NORFOLK DISTRICT & VDHR PROGRAMMATIC STREAMLINED ACTIVITIES LIST

Programmatic Streamlined Activities are permits that have streamlined coordination with the Virginia Department of Historic Resources (VDHR) per the 1996 Programmatic Agreement between Norfolk District, VDHR and the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation. Activities qualifying for streamlined review do not require coordination, provided information from VDHR's database (Virginia Cultural Resources Information System (V-CRIS) does not indicate the existence of historic resources (listed on the National Register of Historic Places, determined eligible or potentially eligible for the National Register or noted as not evaluated) within the project area and the activity is not associated with other actions requiring coordination with VDHR.
